

## MMRSL Schedule Information 2009

- 1 All teams will play a double-header against all teams in their respected round-robins (18 games)  
(the lower round-robin will play 2 randomly drawn double-headers to equal the amount of games played by the upper round-robin)
- 2 After the last scheduled round-robin game (July 12), the top 6 teams in the upper round-robin will comprise Division 1. The bottom 6 teams in the lower round-robin will comprise Division 3. The remaining 6 teams will comprise Division 2.
- 3 All teams will play a double-header against all teams within their assigned division
- 4 Teams will play 28 regular season games (18 in the round-robin & 10 more in the divisional play)
- 5 Home team, shown on the right side of the schedule, supplies the game ball and equipment (including placement of the bases)
- 6 Visiting team must provide a back-up ball that is in good shape
- 7 Please check game times, parks and diamond numbers carefully.
- 8 Each game is 7 innings with no new inning starting after 65 minutes
- 9 The players that meet with the umpire when he/she calls for captains at the beginning of the game will be the only players recognized during that game as the Team Reps
- 10 Hustle on and off the field to help finish all seven innings.
- 11 Open and rain-outs game times may be used for practices on a "first come, first serve" basis, provided no league game has been scheduled (check the web site for updates)

**Dunton Athletic Field** - Kennedy Rd (known as Central Parkway south of Eglinton), just north of the #401 on west side

**River Grove** - west side of River Grove, one block west of Creditview between Bristol and Britannia roads
